General Information for All Swim School Classes

Important Waivers

Everyone entering the LJCC must complete the necessary paperwork, including parents and caregivers who drop off and pick up children. If you are already a JCC member, you have probably completed this process, but if not, you must be added to our system and/or complete the required liability waivers. Once completed, you are set and do not need to repeat this every time. Weather Related Communications

The Levine JCC will monitor the constantly changing weather conditions. Updates will be made based on changes to our normal operations. All JCC pools will close in the event there is thunder or lightening, this includes the indoor pool. Updates with regard to any class cancellations will be made to parents via email (if time permits). You may also call the Customer Service Center at 704-366-5007 to check on inclement weather class cancellations and closures.

No Class Days and Holidays

Make Ups/ Credits

We hope for consistency and ease of learning that your child will be able to attend all of their swim lessons; however, we realize this is not always possible. In order to provide the best swim experience for all our students we do not offer specific make-up classes or moving in and out of classes to make up a missed class. The consistency between the instructor and students allows the students to receive an

excellent lesson and improves the outcome for swimming success. Therefore if your child misses a class, we are unable to provide a make-up class. We are also unable to provide make-up classes for circumstances beyond our control such as closings due to inclement weather and closings for "accidents" in the pool.

Locker Rooms

Children under the age of six may use the locker rooms with their parents. Children age six and older must use the appropriate locker room based on gender identity or the all-gender restroom. Please place your belongings in the lockers or cubbies provided. For the convenience of all parents, please do not leave personal items on the benches. This allows for everyone to have a place to sit.

Preschool Swim, Grade K-5 Swim, and Transition Tots Classes

Class Time

Please arrive five minutes prior to the start time of your class. All classes will take place at our indoor pool. Preschool and K-5 classes run 45 minutes. Transition Tot classes run 30 minutes.

Parent Observation / Waiting Area

Parents/caregivers are asked to wait for their student off the pool deck. You may drop off and pick up only. Please wait on the bleachers in adjacent gymnasium, outside if weather permits, or in the main lobby of the LJCC.

First Day of Class Evaluations

On the first day of new session, we will evaluate each student during the first moments of class. The purpose of this brief evaluation is to allow us to place students in groups with other like-skilled students. If your child has been in our swim school previously, and we are aware of his/her skill level, please be patient during this brief process.

Student / Instructor Ratio

Preschool Classes 4:1
K-5 Classes 5:1
Transitional Tot 3:1

If you have previously participated in our

group lessons, please note you may not have the same instructor as your previous session. Please be aware and prepare your child if necessary.

Swim Suits and Goggles

Please send your child with goggles for their lesson. Please do not dress your child in one-piece swim suits in order to simplify bathroom breaks. Recommended swim goggles, search: **Speedo Unisex-Child Swim Goggles Sunny G Ages 3-8** available on www.amazon.com.

Infant & Toddler Classes

Class Time

Please arrive no more than five minutes prior to the start time of your class. Please wait on the pool deck and out-of-the-water until your class begins. All classes will take place at our indoor pool. Infant and Toddler classes run 30 minutes.

Swim Diapers

Please bring your child dressed and ready to enter the water in a swim diaper and a swim-suit with elastic fitting around the legs.

Parent Involvement in the Water

The purpose of the Infant and Toddler class is water acclimation, fun and safety. Enjoy this time with your child. You are making MEMORIES! One parent/caregiver is allowed to be with the student in the water, as well as on the pool deck. We kindly ask that the second parent or caregiver waits outside of pool area during the lesson.
