The Annual Kids Triathlon is a fundraising and participatory event. All participants are required to raise a minimum amount of money.

MINIMUM FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENT:

\$30/Individual or \$55/Family

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

Children between the ages of 5-14, of all athletic abilities. Participants will participate in heats, divided by age group.

Age categories

Age 5-8: 25 meter swim / 1 mile bike / .25 mile run

Age 9-11: 50 meter swim / 1 mile bike / .75 mile run

Age 12-14: 100 meter swim / 2 mile bike / .75 mile run

RACE ENTRY FEES:

Register early; this event fills up fast!

\$40 Early Bird (Feb 1–Mar 6)

\$45 Regular (Mar 7–Apr 20)

\$50 Late (Apr 21–May 16)

Registration will close when maximum capacity is reached. *If space is still available on race day, same-day registrants will be charged the late registration fee, as well as the minimum fundraising requirement to participate.*
