

FINDING CENTER: A Year of Growth and Community at Levine JCC!

DEAR LEVINE JCC MEMBERS,

When I arrived at the Levine JCC in February of 2023 I was intrigued to learn about that year's annual theme; "Find Your Center." Little did we know the profound resonance it would carry throughout 2023, not only for me as the new CEO but for the entire Charlotte Jewish community.

The theme's significance expanded beyond my personal journey, touching the lives of numerous others who discovered their center within our vibrant community over the past year. As we reflect on this transformative period, let's explore some remarkable highlights that define our collective experience:

- Community Growth:** Welcoming 1,800 new JCC members, our community has flourished, embracing diverse perspectives and backgrounds.
- Summer Camp Adventures:** Engaging 350 first-time campers in activities ranging from swimming and singing to sports and Israeli crafts. These newcomers formed lasting connections with the 850 returning campers, fostering a sense of unity.
- Team Expansion:** Our JCC staff team grew by 350 members, including dedicated summer camp counselors, lifeguards, and swim instructors. This expansion underscores our commitment to providing exceptional experiences.

Amidst the vibrant tapestry of events, we hosted nearly 4,000 community participants, contributing to the success of special events like the Charlotte Jewish Film Festival, the Levine JCC Kids Triathlon benefiting pediatric rehabilitation services, and the annual Purim Carnival. Additionally, our dedication to education shone through as we reached 4,911 students with the Levine JCC Butterfly Project, imparting crucial lessons from the Holocaust.

In these challenging times, our JCC has become a haven for positivity and meaningful impact. Despite the weight on our hearts due to the crisis in Israel and the prevailing Antisemitism, we recognize our pivotal role in the lives of families and individuals. The JCC stands as a pillar of support, offering health, wellness, social and emotional connections, and meaningful Jewish experiences.

As our JCC family continues to grow, it's heartening to know that word of mouth remains the primary reason people join us. Whether it's the allure of our world-class facilities, the camaraderie on our new pickleball courts, the creativity in ceramics classes, the energy of JFORCE, the energy at Camp Mindy, the competition on the basketball court, or simply the joy of making new friends, individuals *find their center* here.

When we surveyed our community, the feedback directly from our members resonates deeply:

77% **Jewish Identity:**

77% feel a stronger connection to their Jewish identity.

90% **Community Well-being:**

An impressive 90% believe the JCC significantly contributes to the well-being of our local community.

As CEO, these sentiments are a testament to the unwavering commitment, passion, and dedication of our exceptional staff and board. One member's heartfelt words encapsulate the essence of our community:

"I love the inclusive and supportive community culture that has been created here. I feel at home, and I feel that I am accepted and belong. I love the staff who are always friendly and helpful. Everything offered at the JCC is very well done."

Levine JCC's Adaptive Swim Program

Adaptive Swim Lessons

Therapeutic and calming, water provides feelings of weightlessness, relief from pain, improved balance, range of motion and strength, coordination, and may help reduce sensory overload.

Our new Adaptive Swim Program uses modified/adaptive techniques to accommodate an individual's abilities, needs, and goals by placing an emphasis on swimming skills and water safety. Specially trained and certified instructors work with the individual and family to set obtainable goals relating to pool/water safety, swimming skills, and/or adapted stroke techniques to ensure their success in and around the water.

Nate

The J pool has been Nate's "happy place" since before he could walk. Nate started taking swim classes as a baby at the J in the parent and me classes, and has not left the pool since. The J pool has been one of the most consistent places of happiness and fun for Nate his whole life. When Nate was 4 years old, he was diagnosed on the Autism Spectrum. One of the hardest things for us was to find a physical activity for Nate (who loves to be physically active and has a hard time being on a big team). We tried some group sports, but the larger group setting was just not for him.

Nate went from the baby and parent classes, to some private lessons and then when he was old enough

he attended the preschool group swim lessons. Nate loved swimming, but he eventually aged out of group swim lessons and we thought Swim Team might be too much for him (too many people and too loud). We realized that the only way to keep Nate in the pool year round was going to be private lessons. One of the cool things that we learned is that the J was actively training their swim staff to teach adaptive swim, which is helpful to teach swim to children and young adults with special needs.

Nate can be found at the J in swimming lessons at the pool a couple of afternoons a week during the school year. In the summer months he can't wait for the outdoor pool to open, and he fell in love with the waterslide last summer.

The J is such a special place for our family. It is a blessing to have such an inclusive facility that employs instructors and encourages employees to take special classes to learn how to teach kids and young adults from all backgrounds and abilities. It is clear that the J is all in and we can't wait to see what the future years bring.

Merrin Teen Professional Fellowship

An 18-Month Professional Development Program for JCC Professionals Who Work with Teens

THE MERRIN TEEN PROFESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP is based on the idea that the key to creating a vibrant future is connecting our teens to meaningful Jewish experiences today.

This 16-18 month long fellowship provides an intensive, transformative professional development program to JCC professionals who are early in their career and wish to dig deeper into their professional journey. It supports their growth within the JCC Movement, their work with teens, and their advancement as a Jewish communal professional.

There are four core areas of focus for the cohort:

- Jewish Literacy
- Understanding Adolescence
- Networking
- Leadership Development

The program includes several in-person seminars, including one that takes place in Israel.

Since 1999, more than 125 Merrin Fellows have completed this professional development program, and hundreds of thousands of teens have been influenced by their important work.
